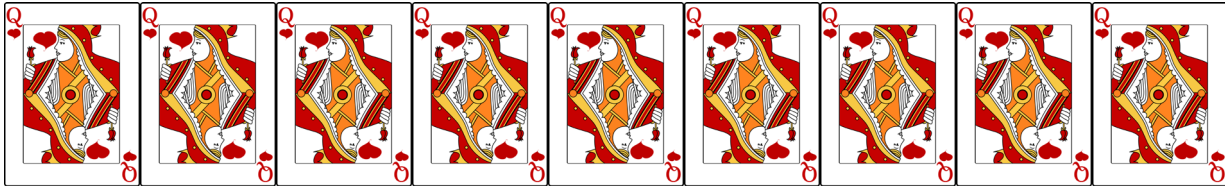

Queen of Hearts Rules

How it Works

- The "Queen of Hearts" Raffle is a weekly progressive raffle. A standard deck of cards, including Jokers, (for a total of 54 cards) have been placed face down and sealed on a mounting board purchased from a gaming vendor.
- Charles County Children's Aid Society (CAS) has purchased an official, sealed board. It is kept locked in a glass-fronted cabinet at PTR Waterfront.
- For a chance to draw the Queen of Hearts, purchase an entry for \$5.00. Ticket purchasers must be 21 years of age or older with valid, government-issued identification (such as a driver's license).
- Tickets are sold in-person only and are available at PTR Waterfront and the CAS office during normal business hours. Tickets may also be available for sale at other CAS events, as determined by the CAS Board of Directors.
- Entries must include legal first and last name, phone number, and the card number selected.
- Jackpot value will be announced prior to each drawing and may be posted on CAS website in advance of the drawing.
- Each Friday at 7:30pm, there will be a random drawing from the tickets sold during that sales period for the chance to reveal the Queen of Hearts. The drawing will be conducted in-person at PTR Waterfront by representatives of CAS. If less than **50 tickets** have been sold during the sales period, the drawing will be postponed to the following week.
- Once the winning ticket has been selected, the chosen card will be revealed on the board. Payouts are as described below.
- Each week, all non-winning entries are discarded and new entries will be sold.
- The total prize pool will continue to accumulate weekly until the Queen of Hearts is drawn.

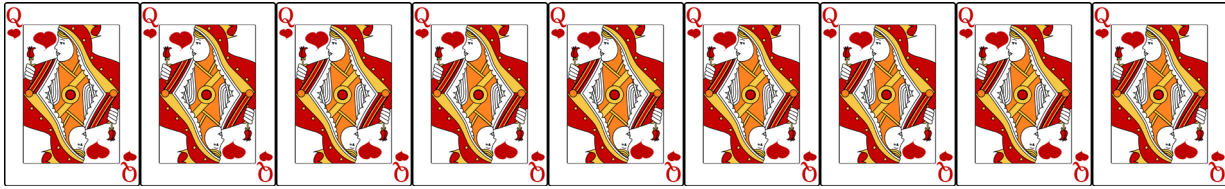


Payout Structure

- The winning entry that correctly selects the **Queen of Hearts** will receive 50% of the net total proceeds accumulated since the start of the raffle. The remaining proceeds go to Charles County Children's Aid Society, who may choose to apply up to 10% as the starting jackpot for a subsequent drawing.
- **Joker Cards:** \$100.00
- **Face Cards and Aces:** \$50.00
- **2-10 Cards:** \$25.00
- Any **heart** (other than the queen) also wins one entry in the following week's drawing
- CAS will file the appropriate IRS forms for any jackpots over \$600. CAS will withhold 25% tax if the prize is more than \$5,000.
- For any payout over \$100, winner will make arrangements with CAS office staff to provide proof of identity and claim their winnings at the CAS office within 4 business days of the drawing.
- Payouts of \$100 or less will be made at the time of the drawing, provided the winner is present.
- Winners need not be present to win, however if they are not present, CAS will make reasonable attempts to contact them at the phone number provided on the ticket and the winner must make arrangements to show proof of identity and claim winnings with the CAS office staff within 4 days of the drawing.

Game Integrity

The Board of Directors of the Charles County Children's Aid Society ("the Board") will address any and all discrepancies with final say in the adjudication of any discrepancies. The Board reserves the right to change or alter the rules of the game at any time they deem appropriate. In the event the Board elects to discontinue the raffle, CAS will conduct one final drawing in which tickets will be drawn until the Queen of Hearts is selected and a jackpot winner is awarded. The Board will provide the initial starting jackpot of \$1,000.



The Legal Fine Print

- All sales of Raffle tickets are final. No refunds or replacements of lost or stolen Raffle tickets will be issued. CAS nor its officers, employees, agents or other representatives assumes any responsibility or liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible or undelivered entries, or any other failure to receive entries, or any failure to deliver a receipt of purchase prior to the drawing deadlines.
- Notification of Official Grand Prize Winner: CAS will have the sole discretion to determine whether an owner of an Entry selected at the Drawing (the "Potential Grand Prize Winner") is an Eligible Entrant and otherwise eligible to be the winner of the Prize in accordance with these Official Rules ("Official Grand Prize Winner"). As a condition of its right to collect a Prize and become an Official Grand Prize Winner, a Potential Grand Prize Winner must deliver to CAS
 - a.) a signed statement certifying that the Potential Grand Prize Winner is the rightful owner of the winning Entry in accordance with these Official Rules and all applicable laws;
 - b.) such written information as is required by any applicable laws, including tax regulations, such as the Potential Grand Prize Winner's name, address and social security number; and
 - c.) proof of both identity and age in forms satisfactory to CAS decision concerning the sufficiency of documentation issued to evidence the identity, age and eligibility of the Potential Grand Prize Winner to become an Official Grand Prize Winner shall be final and binding. If a Potential Grand Prize Winner cannot be contacted and/or notified after reasonable attempts at the drawing location by CAS or if the Grand Prize cannot be awarded for any other reason, representatives will split the "net proceeds" with 50% going to CAS. and 50% carrying over to start the next "Queen of Hearts Raffle".
- Donation of Prize: In order to donate the prize, the Grand Prize Winner must first take ownership of the prize, which means the appropriate W-2G must be issued and withholding taken (if applicable) prior to the donation being made and acknowledged.
- Publicity Release: By accepting the Grand Prize from CAS the Grand Prize Winner hereby officially grants CAS, PTRW and their designees and affiliates full permission to use the Official Grand Prize Winner's name, biographical information, photograph, voice and/or other likeness and prize information on a royalty-free basis for advertising, trade, promotional and any other purposes in any and all media or format now known or hereafter devised, worldwide and on the internet, in perpetuity, without limitation, and without compensation, consideration, permission, notice, review or approval, unless prohibited by law.
- Release of Liability: In consideration of being allowed to participate in the raffle, Eligible Entrant hereby agrees to release and discharge CAS a Maryland Not-For Profit Organization, PTRW, their affiliates, and all of their officers, employees, agents and volunteers (collectively "Released Parties") from any and all liability, injuries, losses or damage of any kind (including, without limitation, attorney's fees) caused by the Raffle, these Official Rules, participation in the Raffle or winning any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize.
- Mandatory Arbitration Agreement: Any controversy or claim, other than a claim by CAS out of or relating to the Raffle or to these Official Rules must be resolved in accordance with the below arbitration provisions, any purchaser of a Raffle ticket, including but not limited to any Eligible Entrants, Potential Grand Prize Winners or Official Grand Prize Winners, agrees to arbitrate any and all claims and disputes relating in any way to such purchase and/or to the selection of an Official Grand Prize Winner, and/or the award of the Grand Prize, and/or the delivery of the Grand Prize, and/ or the Raffle generally ("Arbitration Claim"), through binding individual arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association (pursuant to its expedited procedures) under its Consumer Arbitration Rules, with arbitration proceedings to be conducted in Charles County MD by a mutually agreed upon arbiter. Judgment rendered by the Arbitrator(s) may be entered by CAS in any court having proper jurisdiction. CAS may exercise any lawful rights to seek provisional remedies or self-help without waiving the right to arbitrate by doing so.
- Class Action Waiver: All Participants in the Raffle hereby agree to waive the right to a court or jury trial. Arbitrators may not consolidate the arbitration claims of multiple parties. All arbitration claims and disputes shall be arbitrated on an individual basis and not as a class action, representative action, class arbitration or any similar proceeding. Prior to initiation of an arbitration proceeding under this section, anyone initiating an arbitration claim must first provide at least Thirty (30) days prior written notice to CAS. Prior to any arbitration proceeding, CAS must first be provided with a reasonable opportunity to resolve any dispute. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any claims belonging to CAS arising out of or related to the Raffle.
- Limitation of Liability: The sole and exclusive remedy for any claim against CAS and/or PTRW arising out of the Raffle, sale of Raffle tickets, awarding of any prizes or the conduct of the raffle shall be limited to the return of the purchase price paid for any applicable Raffle ticket(s), without interest. In no event shall CAS or the released parties be liable to any other party for any loss or injuries to earnings, profits or goodwill, or for any incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages, whether arising in contract, tort or otherwise, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.
- Indemnification: In consideration of being allowed to participate in the Raffle, each purchaser of a Raffle ticket forming an entry hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the released parties harmless from and against any and all costs, losses, damages, rights, claims, liabilities and actions of any kind arising from, in connection with, or as a result of such purchaser's participation in the Raffle or the acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize.
